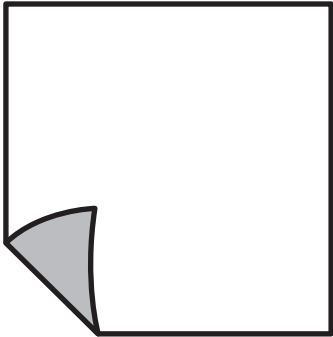
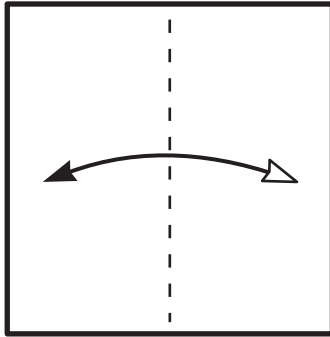


# Flying Squirrel Glider Plane

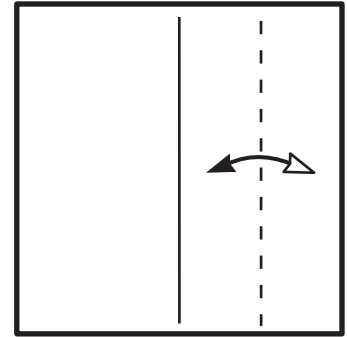
Print out the Flying Squirrel on regular printer paper and cut out the pattern. Don't use paper that is too thick; it will be difficult to fold. You can also try using square origami paper. Use the dotted lines on the instructions to help guide you with the folds.



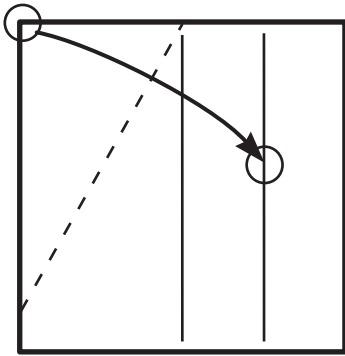
1. Begin with the squirrel image facing up, but upside down. With your right hand, grab the bottom left hand corner of the graphic and flip the paper over.



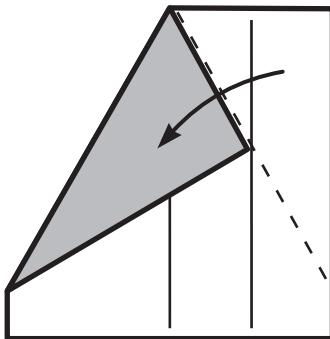
1b. The blank side of the paper will now be facing up. Fold the square in half (as shown), then unfold. Fold the right side toward the center, then unfold.



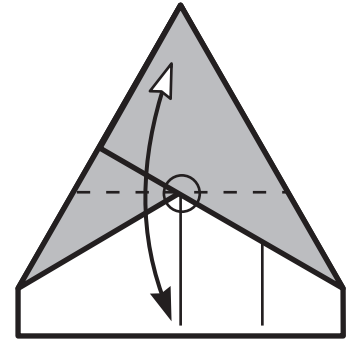
2. Fold the right side toward the center, then unfold.



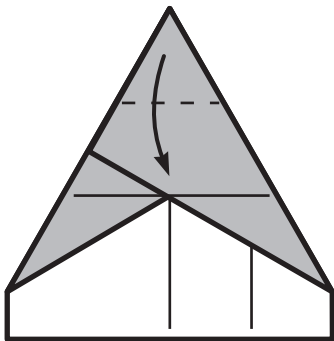
3. Fold the top corner of the left side so that the corner meets the fold line that was created in step 2.



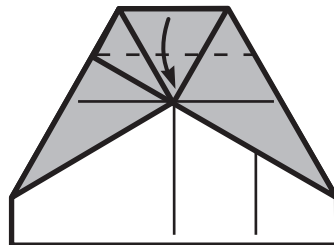
4. Using the dotted line as your guide, fold over the top corner of the right side.



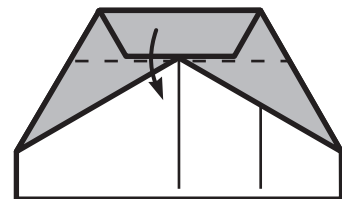
5. Fold and unfold the top point, as shown. Use the dotted line on the above diagram to make sure the fold is at the point where the two layers meet.



6. Fold the top point toward the fold line that was created in step 5.



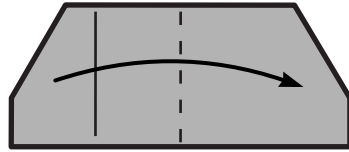
7. Fold the top point toward the fold line created in step 5.



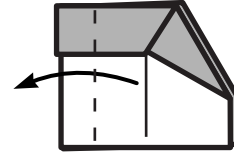
8. Fold the top toward the fold line created in step 5, as shown.



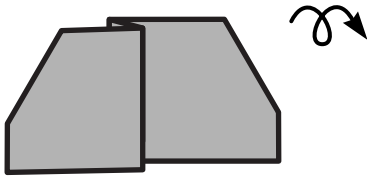
9. Turn the squirrel glider over.



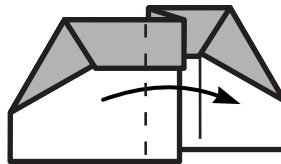
10. Fold the squirrel glider in half.



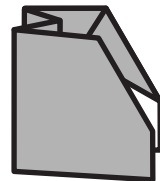
11. Fold the top layer toward the left side, at the fold line indicated in the above diagram.



12. Turn the squirrel glider over.



13. Fold the other layer toward the right side, at the fold line indicated in the above diagram.



14. Open to reveal the glider.
